THE following is the copy of an Order of His Majesty in Council, for dividing the parish of Merthyr Tydvil, in the county of Glamorgan, into two distinct and separate parishes, under the 16th section of the 58th of George the Third, cap. 134;

At the Court at Saint James's, the 1st day of March 1837, present, the King's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.
