

quarter sessions or some special sessions assembled, as mentioned in the Act, passed in the third year of the reign of His said late Majesty, intitled "An Act to settle and determine the division of counties, and the limits of cities and boroughs, in England and Wales, in so far as respects the election of Members to serve in Parliament," shall, conformably to the said last-mentioned Act, divide such county, riding, parts, or division into convenient polling districts, and assign one of such districts to each polling place:

And whereas the justices of the county of Derby, in quarter sessions assembled at Chesterfield, the third day of April one thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight, have presented two several petitions to Her Majesty, representing that the number of polling places for the northern division of the said county is insufficient, and therefore praying, that the towns of Buxton and Tideswell may be polling places for the said northern division:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, having taken the said petitions into consideration, doth, pursuant to the said Act of the seventh year of His late Majesty's reign, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, declare, order, and direct, that the towns of Buxton and Tideswell shall be polling places for the said northern division; and further, that the justices of the peace for the said county, assembled in quarter sessions or some special sessions, as mentioned in the said Act of the third year of His late Majesty's reign, shall, conformably to the said last-mentioned Act, divide the said northern division into convenient polling districts, and assign one of such districts to each polling place.
