The QUEEN's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

IT is this day ordered by Her Majesty in  
Council, that the Parliament be prorogued from  
Thursday the sixth day of October next to Thurs-  
day the tenth day of November next.

PRESENT,

The QUEEN's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

IT is this day ordered by Her Majesty in  
Council, that his Grace the Archbishop of  
Canterbury do prepare a Form of Prayer and  
Thanksgiving to Almighty God for the late  
abundant harvest; and that such Form of Prayer  
and Thanksgiving be used in all churches and  
chapels in England and Wales, and in the town  
of Berwick-on-Tweed, on Sunday the second  
day of October next.

The Queen has been pleased to revoke the  
several letters patent under the Great Seal of the  
United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,  
bearing date, respectively, the 24th day of July  
1824, the 2d day of April 1825, the 11th day of  
May 1826, and the 24th day of September 1838,  
under which the existing diocese of Barbados and  
the Leeward Islands, and the several archdeacon-  
ries in the said recited letters patent mentioned  
were constituted, save and except as to all matters  
and things done, or proceedings at law com-  
menced, under the authority of the said letters  
patent, or any of them; and to make, ordain,  
establish, and constitute the parochial church of  
Saint Michael, in Bridgetown, in the island of  
Barbados, to be a cathedral church and bishop's  
see; and to make, ordain, establish, and constitute  
the said city, and all the island of Barbados, and  
the islands of Trinidad, Grenada, Saint Vincent,  
Tobago, and Saint Lucia, with their respective  
dependencies, to be a separate and distinct diocese,  
to be called henceforth "The Diocese of Bar-  
bados:" and Her Majesty has been further pleased  
to nominate and appoint the Reverend Thomas  
Parry, Doctor in Divinity, to be consecrated  
bishop of the said see: and Her Majesty has been  
further pleased to found and constitute one arch-  
deaconry within the said diocese, in and over the  
islands of Barbados, Saint Vincent, and Saint  
Lucia, and their respective dependencies, to be  
styled "The Archdeaconry of Barbados;" and also  
one other archdeaconry, in and over the islands of  
Trinidad, Grenada, and Tobago, with their re-  
spective dependencies, to be styled "The Arch-  
deaconry of Trinidad."

The Queen has also been pleased to make,  
ordain, establish, and constitute the parochial  
church of Saint John, in the town of Saint John,
