" 5. That in every cathedral church in which any plan for the preaching of the honorary canons therein shall be agreed upon by the dean and chapter, with the consent of their visitor, every honorary canon appointed in the same church shall conform to such plan; provided that he shall not be required so to preach more than once in

And whereas the said scheme has been approved by Her Majesty in Council; now, therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice of Her said Council, is pleased hereby to ratify the said scheme, and to order and direct that the same, and every part thereof, shall be effectual in law immediately from and after the time when this Order shall have been duly published in the London Gazette, pursuant to the said Acts; and Her Majesty, by and with the like advice, is pleased hereby to direct, that this Order be forthwith registered by the Registrars of the several dioceses of Carlisle, Chester, Durham, Ely, Gloucester and Bristol, Norwich, Peterborough, Ripon, Rochester, Winchester, and Worcester.
