

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, having taken the said petition into consideration, doth hereby, in pursuance of the said Act, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, declare, order, and direct, that the county of Northampton shall be divided into three districts for the purposes of the said Act, and that such districts shall be respectively called, the Eastern District, the Midland District, and the Western District; and that such districts respectively shall be constituted as follows, that is to say:

The said Eastern District shall comprise the following parishes and places: Addington Great, Addington Little, Aldwinkle All Saints', Aldwinkle Saint Peter's, Apethorpe, Armston, Artlingworth, Ashley, Ashton, Barnwell All Saints, Barnwell Saint Andrew, Barton Seagrave, Benefield, Blatherwycke, Bowden Little, Brigstock, Brampton Ash, Braybrooke, Broughton, Bulwick, Burton Lattimer, Carlton, so much of Catworth Township as is in the county of Northampton, Chelveston cum Caldecott, Clapton, Clipston, Collyweston, Corby, Cotterstock, Cottingham, Cranford Saint Andrew, Cranford Saint John, Cransley, Deene, Deenthorpe, Denford, Desborough, Dingley, Droughton, Duddington, East Farndon, Easton on the Hill, Faxton, Fineshade, Fotheringhay, Geddington, Glaphthorn, Glendon and Barford, Grafton Underwood, Gretton, Hanging Houghton, Hannington, Hardwick, Hargrave, Harrowden Great, Harrowden Little, Harringworth, Harrington, Hazlebeeche, Hemington, Higham Ferrers, Hothorpe, Irchester, Irthlingborough, Isham, Islip, Kelmars, Kettering, Kingscliffe, Lamport, Laxton, Lilford-cum-Wigsthorpe, Loddington, Lowick, Luddington, Lutton, Maidwell, Marston Trussell, Middleton, Nassington, Newton Bromshold, Newton-in-the Willows, Oakley Great, Oakley Little, Old otherwise Wold, Oringbury, Orton, Oundle, Oxenden Great, Pilton, Polebrooke, Pytchley, Raunds, Ringstead, Rockingham, Rowell otherwise Rothwell, Rushden, Rushton, Sibbertoft, Slipton, Southwick, Stanion, Stanwick, Stoke Albany, Stoke Doyle, Sudborough, Sulby, Sutton Bassett, Tansor, Thingdon otherwise Finedon, Thorpe Achurch, Thorpe Malsor, Thrapston, Thurning, Titchmarsh, Twywell, Wadenhoe, Walgrave, Wakerley, Warkton, Warmington, Weekley, Weldon Great, Weldon Little, Wellingborough, Weston-by-Welland, Wilbarston, Winwick, Woodford, Woodnewton, Yarwell, and all other places (if any), in the county of Northampton (except the hundred of Nassaburgh), which are situated to the north of the following parishes, or any of them, that is to say, the parishes of Farndish, Great Doddington, Wilby, Mears Ashby, Sywell, Holcot, Scaldwell, Brixworth, Cottesbrooke, Naseby, and Welford.

And the said midland district shall comprise the following parishes and places, Abington, Ashby Saint Ledgers, Ashton, Badby, Barby, Billing Great, Billing Little, Bozeat, Blisworth, Boughton, Brafield on the Green, Braunston, Brington, Brixworth, Brockhall, Bugbrooke, Catesby, Castle Ashby, Chapel Brampton, Church Brampton, Claycoton, Cold Ashby, Cooknoe, Collingtree, Coton, Cottesbrooke, Courteenhall, Crick, Creaton Great, Creaton Little, Dallington, Daventry, Denton, Doddington Great, Dodford, Duston, Earl's Barton, East Haddon, Exton, Easton Mauditt, Elkington, Everdon, Farndish, Farthingstone, Fawsley, Floore, Gayton, Grendon, Guilsborough, Hackleton, Hardingstone, Harlestone, Harpole, Hartwell, Hellidon, Heyford Nether, Heyford Upper, Holcot, Holdenby, Hollowell, Horton, Houghton Great, Houghton Little,

Kilsby, Kingsthorpe, Kislingbury, Lilbourn, Litchborough, Long Buckby, Mears Ashby, Milton otherwise Middleton Malsor, Moulton, Naseby, Newnham, Nortoft, Norton, Overstone, Pattishall, Piddington, Pitsford, Preston Deanry, Quinton, Ravensthorpe, Roade, Rothersthorpe, Scaldwell, Shutlanger, Spratton, Stanford, Staverton, Strixton, Stoke Bruerne, Stowe-nine-Churches, Sywell, Teeton, Thornby, Upton, Watford, Weedon Beck, Welton, Welford, Weston Favell, West Haddon, Whilton, Whiston, Wilby, Winwick, Wollaston, Wootton, Yardley Hastings, Yelvertoft, and all other places (if any) in the said county of Northampton (except the town and borough of Northampton), which are situate to the south of the several parishes following, or any of them, that is to say, the several parishes of Newton Bromshold, Rushden, Irchester, Wellingborough, Hardwick, Hannington, Walgrave, Old, Lamport, Hanging Houghton, Maidwell, Hazlebeeche, Kelmars, Clipstone, Sibbertoft, and Sully, and to the north of the several parishes following, or any of them, that is to say: the parishes of Grafton Regis, Alderton, Easton Neston, Towcester, Greensnorton, Cold Higham, Maidford, Preston Capes, Charwelton, and Byfield.

And the said western district shall comprise the following parishes and places: Abthorpe with Fosote, Adston, Alderton, Aston-le-Walls, Astwell and Falcutt, Aynho, Blakesley, Boddington Lower, Boddington Upper, Brackley Saint James, Brackley Saint Peter, Bradden, Byfield, Canons Ashby, Chacombe, Charwelton, Chippingwarden, Cold Higham, Cosgrove, Croughton, Culworth, Easton Neston, Edgcott, Evenley, Eydon, Farthinghoe, Furtho, Grafton Regis, Greatworth, Greensnorton, Helmdon, Hinton-in-the-Hedges, Kingsulton, Maidford, Marston Saint Lawrence, Middleton Cheney, Morton Pinkney, Newbottle, Passenham, Paulerspury, Preston Capes, Plumpton, Potterspury, Radstone, Silverstone, Slapton, Steane, Stuckbury, Sulgrave, Syresham, Thenford, Thorpe Mandeville, Tiffield, Towcester, Wappenham, Warkworth, Weston and Weedon, Whittlebury, Whitfield, Wicken, Woodford-cum-Membris, Woodend, Yardley Gobion: and all other places (if any) in the said county of Northampton, which lie to the south of the several parishes following, or any of them, that is to say: the parishes of Hartwell, Ashton, Stoke Bruerne, Shutlanger, Tiffield, Pattishall, Stowe-nine-Churches, Litchborough, Farthingstone, Fawsley and Hellidon.

And it is hereby further declared, ordered, and directed, that the court for the election of coroner within each of the said districts respectively, when and as often as the same shall become necessary under the provisions of the said Act, shall be holden at the places hereinafter mentioned, that is to say: for the said eastern district, at the town of Kettering; for the said midland district, at the town of Northampton; and for the said western district, at the town of Brackley.

And it is hereby further ordered that this Order shall be published in the London Gazette.
