Liverpool Docks.

(Repeal or Amendment of portions of existing Acts.)

NOTICE is hereby given, that application will be made to Parliament in the ensuing session for an Act to alter, amend, or repeal the provisions of the Acts (local and personal) herein-after mentioned; that is to say: 9th and 10th Victoria, cap. 109, and 11th and 12th Victoria, cap. 10, and the several Acts therein respectively recited or referred to, so far as the same relate to the employment and regulation of the porters engaged in receiving, weighing, and loading off the cargoes of vessels entering or using the docks, basins, or quays of the Trustees of the Liverpool Docks, and to vary, alter, or extinguish the exclusive privileges now enjoyed by the master porters appointed or acting under the provisions of such Acts, or any of them, with respect to the receiving, weighing, and loading off the cargoes of such vessels; and to make other provisions in lieu thereof.—Dated this twenty-ninth day of October one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine.
