

And it is also intended to authorize the Mayor, Aldermen, and Burgesses to make and levy rates and assessments upon the owners and occupiers of property within the said borough, and to authorize the application of the borough fund or any money or property of the said Mayor, Aldermen, and Burgesses, for carrying into effect all or any of the purposes of the said Bill; and it is intended to alter existing rates, tolls, duties, fees, and charges, and to confer exemptions from existing rates, tolls, and duties, and also from the proposed rates and assessments, and to authorize the raising of money upon mortgage of the rates and assess-

ments to be levied under and by virtue of the intended Act. And it is also intended to take powers for the compulsory purchase of lands and houses for any of the purposes aforesaid, and to restrain the collection of tolls upon any turnpike-roads within the said borough, and to place the management of all the roads in the said Mayor, Aldermen, and Burgesses, and to confer, vary, or extinguish rights and privileges connected with the objects hereinbefore mentioned.
