THE Commissioners for executing the office of Lord High Admiral of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland do hereby give notice, that, on Tuesday the 23rd of April next, at one o'clock, they will be ready to treat with such persons as may be willing to contract for supplying Her Majesty's Dockyards at Deptford, Portsmouth, and Devonport with

14,415 BOLTS OF CANVASS, (Including 1045 Bolts of 18 inches wide), to be delivered by the 31st of December next.

Tenders may be made for any quantity not less than 1000 Bolts, and no tender will be received

unless made on the printed form, properly filled up, which, together with "Instructions for making the Canvass," may be obtained on application to this Office.

No tender will be received after one o'clock on the day of treaty, nor any noticed unless the party attends, or an agent for him duly authorized in writing.

Every tender must be addressed to the Secretary of the Admiralty, and bear in the left-hand corner the words "Tender for Canvass," and must also be delivered at Somerset-place, accompanied by a letter, signed by two responsible persons, engaging to become bound with the person tendering in the sum of £25 per cent on the value for the due performance of the contract.
