

Buckingham-Palace, March 31, 1852.

This day had audience of Her Majesty:

His Royal Highness the Count of Aquila, Brother of His Majesty the King of the Kingdom of the Two Sicilies, attended by the Prince di Carini, Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary of His Sicilian Majesty;

His Royal Highness was introduced to Her Majesty by the Earl of Malmesbury, Her Majesty's Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, and conducted by Major-General the Honourable Sir Edward Cust, K.C.H. Master of the Ceremonies.

Her Royal Highness the Countess of Aquila had audience of Her Majesty at the same time.
