

"18a. That the patronage of the rectory of Little Hereford with Ashford Carbonel, in the counties of Hereford and Salop, in the diocese of Hereford, now vested in the Chancellor of the cathedral church of Hereford, the patronage of the rectory of Moreton-on-Lugg, in the county and diocese of Hereford, now vested in the Prebendary of the prebend of Moreton Magna, in the said cathedral church, the patronage of the vicarage of Vowchurch, in the same county and diocese, now vested in the Prebendary of the prebend of Putson Major, in the same cathedral church, and the patronage of the vicarage of Walford, in the counties of Hereford and Gloucester, and in the diocese of Hereford, and which said patronage, upon the vacancies of such chancellorship, prebends, and precentorship respectively, would devolve on the Bishop of Hereford, be upon such vacancies respectively transferred unto and thenceforth be and remain vested in the Bishop of Worcester and his successors.

"19. That, upon the next avoidance of the see

of Winchester, and the consequent transfer to the see of Lichfield of the patronage hereinbefore directed to be transferred to that see upon that event, the patronage of the following benefices; that is to say:

The vicarage of Bishops Itchington, with its chapelries,

The vicarage of Dunchurch,

The vicarage of Tachbrook,

all in the county of Warwick and diocese of Worcester, and which patronage is now vested in the Bishop of Lichfield, shall be transferred unto and thenceforth be and remain vested in the Bishop of Worcester and his successors.

"20. That the patronage of the several benefices comprised in the Table IX., hereinafter set forth, and which said patronage is now vested in the several bishops whose names are, in the said Table IX. set opposite to the names of the said benefices, be transferred unto and thenceforth be and remain vested in the Bishop of Gloucester and Bristol and his successors.

"21. That, upon the next avoidance of the see of Winchester, the patronage of the rectory of Little Hinton and of the vicarage of Wroughton, in the county of Wilts, and in the diocese of Gloucester and Bristol, and which said patronage is now vested in the Bishop of Winchester, be transferred unto and thenceforth be and remain vested in the Bishop of Gloucester and Bristol and his successors.

"22. That the patronage of the several benefices comprised in the Table X., hereinafter set forth, and which said patronage is now vested in the respective bishops whose names are, in the said Table X. set opposite to the names of the said benefices, be transferred unto and thenceforth be and remain vested in the Bishop of Peterborough and his successors.
