The **QUEEN'S** Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

**H**ER Majesty in Council was this day pleased to declare the Right Honourable Granville George Earl Granville Lord President of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, and his Lordship took his place at the Board accordingly.

This day the Right Honourable Sir William Molesworth, Bart.; the Right Honourable Sir John Young, Bart.; and the Right Honourable Edward Cardwell, were by Her Majesty's command sworn of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, and took their respective places at the Board accordingly.

Her Majesty in Council was this day pleased to deliver the Great Seal to the Right Honourable Robert Monsey, Lord Cranworth, whereupon the oath of Lord Chancellor of Great Britain was, by Her Majesty's command, administered to His Lordship; and His Lordship took his place at the Board accordingly.

Her Majesty having been pleased to appoint the Most Noble Henry Duke of Newcastle, the Right Honourable John Russell (commonly called Lord John Russell), and the Right Honourable Henry John Viscount Palmerston, to be three of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, they were this day, by Her Majesty's command, sworn three of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State accordingly.
