THIS day the Most Noble George Douglas
Duke of Argyll, the Right Honourable
John Robert Viscount Sydney, were by Her
Majesty's command sworn of Her Majesty's Most
Honourable Privy Council, and took their re-
spective places at the Board accordingly.

Her Majesty having been pleased to deliver the
custody of the Privy Seal to the Most Noble
George Douglas Duke of Argyll, the oath of
Keeper of the Privy Seal was this day adminis-

tered to him, and his Grace took his place at the
Board accordingly.

Her Majesty in Council was this day pleased to
declare the Right Honourable Edward Granville,
Earl of St. Germans, Lieutenant-General, and
General-Governor of that part of the United
Kingdom, called Ireland.

Her Majesty in Council was this day pleased to
appoint the Right Honourable Edward John Lord
Stanley of Alderley, President of the Committee
of Council appointed for the consideration of all
matters relating to Trade and Foreign Plantations,
in the absence of the President of the said Com-
mittee for the time being.
