IT is hereby notified, that official information has been received from Rear Admiral Sir Edmund Lyons, G.C.B., commanding Her Majesty's Naval Forces in the Black Sea, dated Her Majesty's ship Agamemnon, off Sevastopol, February 11, 1855, that from the 1st of February last, "the mouth of the River Dniester, the Ports " of Akerman, Ovidiopol, Odessa, all the Ports " situated between Ochakov Point and Kinbourn " Point, including the Ports of Nicolaev and " Kherson, the Rivers Boug and Dnieper; also the " Ports between Kinbourn Point and Cape Tarkan, including the Ports in the Gulph of " Perekop, the Port of Sevastopol, the Ports " comprised between Cape Aia and the Strait of " Kertch, including those of Yalta, Aloushta, " Soudak, Kaffa, or Theodosia. The Port of

" Kertch, the Strait of Kertch, the entrance " to and all the ports in the Sea of Azov, " including especially the Ports of Berdiansk, " Taganrog, and Arabat; the River Don, and " also the Ports of Anapa and Soujak, were strictly " blockaded by a competent force of the Allied " Fleets of France and England."

" That the Ports of Eupatoria, Streltzka, " Kamiesh, Kazatch, and Balaklava were, and " are, and will remain open and free from all " blockade until further notice: and it is hereby " further notified, that all measures authorized by " the Law of Nations, and the respective Treaties " between Her Majesty the Queen of Great " Britain and Ireland and His Imperial Majesty " the Emperor of the French, and the different " Neutral Powers, will be adopted and executed " with respect to all vessels which may attempt " to violate the said Blockade."
