'An Act for the better Local Management of the column of the schedule hereto, and do set out the 'Metropolis,' to be one of the persons to set out the wards into which certain parishes are by the said Act directed to be divided, and to apportion the number of vestrymen to be elected for such parishes respectively among such wards, and also to apportion the number of vestrymen to be elected for any parish already divided into wards under any local Act, and to act separately in such division and apportionment from the other persons appointed or to be appointed by the said Sir George Grey to perform those duties under the said Act, do hereby divide the parish of Saint Mary Islington (being a parish mentioned in Schedule (A.) to the said Act, containing more than two thousand rated householders, and not already divided into wards under any local Act,) into eight wards (none of which contains less than five hundred rated householders), to be distinguished by the numbers mentioned in the first

extent, limits, and boundary lines of the said wards as the same are described in the second column of the said schedule in conjunction with the numbers distinguishing such wards respec-tively; and, having regard, as far as in my judgment it is practicable, as well to the number of persons rated to the relief of the poor in each ward as to the aggregate amount of the sums at which all such persons are rated, do hereby apportion the number of vestrymen to be elected for the said parish among the said wards according to the respective numbers mentioned in the third column of the said schedule in conjunction with such wards respectively.
