NOTICE is hereby given to all persons interested therein, that preparations are now making for the intended distribution of proceeds arising from sundry deals captured at Rafso, between the 1st and 6th September, 1855, by Her Majesty's ships Firefly and Harrier, and the ship-of-war L'Aigle belonging to His Imperial Majesty the Emperor of the French.

Agents or other persons having any just and

legal demand, unliquidated, against the said proceeds are required to transmit the particulars of any such demand to the Registrar of the High Court of Admiralty, in order that the same may be examined, taxed, and allowed by that officer, and paid under the sanction of the Judge of the said Court.

Agents and all other persons holding powers of attorney, prize orders, assignments or other instruments, by virtue of which they may be legally entitled to claim the share belonging to any captor, are requested, with as little delay as possible, to transmit the same, accompanied by the usual documents, to the Prize Branch of the Department of the "Accountant-General of the Navy, Admiralty, Somerset House."
