NOTICE is hereby given to the Officers, Seamen, and Marines, and to all persons interested therein, that the distribution of proceeds arising from the Russian vessel *Sloviano*, captured on the 29th May, 1855, by Her Majesty's ship *Curlaw*, will commence on Monday the 23rd March, 1857, in the Prize Branch of the Department of the "Accountant-General of the Navy, Admiralty, Somerset-House."
