THE Right Honourable the Lords of the Committee of Privy Council for Trade and Plantations have received, through the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, a copy of a Despatch from Her Majesty's Consul at Santo Domingo, enclosing copy of a Decree issued by the Government of the Dominican Republic, prohibiting, from the 1st of July next, foreign vessels from engaging in the coasting trade, except at the ports of Baburuco, Paradis, and Petit Trou, on the southern coast, and at the ports of Bábaro, Macao, and Cabarete, on the northern coast, at which ports vessels will be admitted on payment of a licence fee of four dollars per ton.
