THE Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury having certified to the Commissioners for the Reduction of the National Debt, in pursuance of the Act, 10 Geo. 4, c. 27, sec. 1, that the actual surplus revenue of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, beyond the actual expenditure thereof, for the year ended the 30th day of June, 1860, amounted to the sum of nine hundred and twelve thousand one hundred and sixty-eight pounds ten shillings and seven pence.

The Commissioners for the Reduction of the National Debt hereby give notice, that the sum of two hundred and twenty-eight thousand and forty-two pounds two shillings and seven pence, being one-fourth part of the said surplus of nine hundred and twelve thousand one hundred and sixty-eight pounds ten shillings and seven pence will be applied, under the provisions of the said Act, between the 11th day of October, 1860, and the 31st day of December, 1860, to the following purposes; viz.:
