AT the Court at *Osborne House, Isle of Wight*, the 5th day of *February*, 1862,

PRESENT,

The QUEEN's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

IT is this day ordered by Her Majesty in Council that the prohibitions now subsisting, under Her Majesty's Orders in Council of the thirtieth day of November and the fourth day of December, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-one, on the exportation or carrying coastwise from the Islands of Jersey, Guernsey, Alderney, and Sark, and the Isle of Man, respectively, of

Gunpowder,
Saltpetre,
Nitrate of Soda,
Brimstone,
Arms, Ammunition and Military Stores
(including Percussion Caps and Tubes),
and
Lead,

be, and the said several prohibitions are, hereby taken off.

And the Lieutenant-Governors of Her Majesty's Islands of Jersey, Guernsey, Alderney, and Sark, and the Isle of Man, respectively, for the time being, are to give the necessary directions herein as to them may appertain.
