BY virtue and in pursuance of the provisions of the Statute 20 and 21 Victoria, chapter 77, I, the Right Honourable Sir Cresswell Cresswell, Knight, Judge of Her Majesty's Court of Probate, with the concurrence of the Right Honourable Richard, Lord Westbury, Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain, and of the Right Honourable Sir Alexander James Edmund Cockburn, Baronet, Lord Chief Justice of the Court of Queen's Bench, do repeal all Tables of Fees heretofore fixed and published for the District Registries of the Court of Probate, and the practitioners therein, in respect of Non-contentious Business, and as to personal applications for Grants of Probate and Letters of Administration, and with the concurrence aforesaid, and with the approval of the Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, signified to me by letter, dated the sixteenth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, do hereby affix the annexed Tables of Fees, to be taken by the Officers of the said Court of Probate in the District Registries thereof, and by the Practitioners therein, in respect of the matters aforesaid; and I do hereby direct, with the concurrence aforesaid, that the said existing Tables of Fees be repealed on and after the second day of March, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, and that the said annexed Tables of Fees shall take effect on and after the said second day of March, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three.
