"All that annual sum or rent charge of twenty-four pounds, charged upon, and payable out of, the estate of the Right Honourable Sir Charles Wood, Baronet, M.P., at Bugthorpe aforesaid, under and by virtue of a certain deed, bearing date the sixth day of April, in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-three, and made between the said Sir Charles Wood and others, and the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England.
