THE Right Honourable the Lords of the Committee of Privy Council for Trade have received, from the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, a copy of a Despatch from Her Majesty's Consul at Stettin, reporting that the following reductions in shipping dues have been made by a Royal Prussian Decree, which came into force on the 1st instant :—
