Flushing Jackets, No. 1, 5,000 number; one half to be delivered within four calendar months, and the remainder thereof within two calendar months afterwards, or earlier if preferred by the party tendering.

Blue Cloth, No. 1, 50,000 yards; one half to be delivered within four calendar months, and the remainder thereof within two calendar months afterwards, or earlier if preferred by the party tendering.

Blue Cloth, No. 2, 9,000 yards; one half to be delivered within four calendar months, and the remainder thereof within two calendar months afterwards, or earlier if preferred by the party tendering.

Duck, 400,000 yards; one half to be delivered within four calendar months, and the remainder thereof within two calendar months afterwards, or earlier if preferred by the party tendering.
