## "PART II.

"ALL that Rectorial Tithe Commutation Rent-charge, amounting to two hundred and seven pounds and thirteen shillings, issuing out of and arising upon lands situate within the township of Walton, in the parish of Chesterfield, in the county of Derby.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby grant to the Incumbent of the perpetual curacy of Saint John the Evangelist and Saint Martin, Beverley Minster, with the chapelry of Tickton annexed, in the county of York, and in the diocese of York, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same benefice, one yearly sum or stipend of one hundred and thirteen pounds, such yearly sum or stipend to be payable out of the common fund under our control, and to be calculated as from the 1st day of May, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six, and to be receivable half-yearly on the first day of May and on the first day of November in each and every year: Provided always, that if at any time lands, tithes, or other hereditaments sufficient to produce the said yearly sum or stipend, or any part thereof, shall be annexed by us to the said benefice in substitution for such yearly sum or stipend, or for such part thereof, our liability for the payment of such yearly sum or stipend, or of such part thereof, as the case may be, shall thereupon and thereafter cease and determine.

In witness whereof, we have hereunto set our common seal, this fourth day of April, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, sections five and eleven, do hereby grant and appropriate out of our common fund to the benefice of Boughton, in the county of Nottingham, and in the diocese of Lincoln, one capital sum of one thousand and four hundred pounds sterling, such capital sum to be applicable towards defraying the cost of providing a parsonage or house of residence for the said benefice, according to plans and a specification to be approved by us, either by discharge of the sum or sums of money which may be or become payable under any mortgage of the said benefice effected with our consent, or in such other manner as we may deem fit, such capital sum of one thousand and four hundred pounds, or the balance thereof unapplied to such

purpose, to remain in the meantime in our hands at interest after the rate of three pounds per centum per annum, and such interest to be paid to the incumbent for the time being of the said benefice of Boughton.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in consideration of a benefaction consisting of twenty perches of land, which has been permanently secured to the benefice of Saint Paul, Bryncoedifor, in the county of Merioneth, and in the diocese of Bangor, and in consideration of a further benefaction of one hundred and twenty pounds sterling, in respect whereof we have agreed to pay to the incumbent of the said benefice, and to his successors, a yearly sum or stipend of four pounds, do hereby, in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, grant to the incumbent of the said benefice of Saint Paul, Bryncoedifor, and to his successors, to meet such benefaction, one other yearly sum or stipend of five pounds six shillings and eight pence, such lastly-mentioned yearly sum or stipend to be payable out of the common fund under our control, and to be calculated as from the twenty-third day of February, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, and to be receivable half-yearly, on the first day of May and on the first day of November in each and every year: Provided always, that if at any time lands, tithes, or other hereditaments sufficient to produce the said yearly sum or stipend, or any part thereof, shall be annexed by us to the said benefice in substitution for such yearly sum or stipend, or for such part thereof, our liability for the payment of such yearly sum or stipend, or of such part thereof, as the case may be, shall thereupon and thereafter cease and determine.
