to the Vicar of the said parish of Risely, for the time being, in lieu of tithes, may be increased or diminished accordingly, and that the exact amount of the said yearly rent or sum to which the same shall be so increased or diminished shall be declared by the order of the said court, conformably with the directions of the said Act.—Dated this 17th day of December, 1867.
