## SECTION I.

The Laws and Ordinances hereunto appended, viz. :—

1. The Customs Law ;
  2. The Customs Regulations ;
  3. The Customs Penal Law ;
  4. The Zollverein Tariff ;
  5. The Ordinance concerning alterations in the Zollverein Tariff ;
  6. The Law concerning the abolition, by the Zollverein Tariff, of the customary fees for documents and seals affixed to goods ;
  7. The Ordinance respecting the taxing of foreign sugars and syrups ;
  8. The Ordinance respecting the alteration of the tare allowance for sugar ;
  9. The Ordinance respecting the levy of the duty on home-grown tobacco ; and
  10. The Law regulating the use of arms by the Frontier Customs officials ;
- come into force in the Duchy of Lauenburg on the 5th of January, 1868.

## SECTION II.

The Law published in the Collection of Laws of the Confederation (No. 6, page 41), concerning the levy of the duty on salt, comes into force on the same day.

## SECTION III.

No duty will be levied henceforth on goods in transit through the Duchy of Lauenburg.

## SECTION IV.

All enactments contrary to the present Ordinance are hereby abolished. Until further notice, this Ordinance shall have no application to the Feudal Estate of Stintenberg, which is separated from the other parts of the Duchy by the Schall Lake.
