

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the vicarage of Chislet in the county of Kent, and in the diocese of Canterbury, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same benefice, all those tithe commutation rent charges, with their appurtenances, which are particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us, to have and to hold the said tithe commutation rent charges, with their appurtenances, to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever; Provided always, that the said tithe commutation rent charges with their appurtenances so granted and conveyed by us as aforesaid, shall be, and be held to be, in lieu of and substitution for the yearly sums or stipends amounting together to forty pounds; and also in lieu of and substitution for the yearly sum or stipend of two pounds, called or known as "Pettitt's Gift," heretofore payable by us to the Incumbent for the time being of the said vicarage; and furthermore, that the same tithe commutation rent charges shall be charged and chargeable with the payment of the annual sum of two pounds, heretofore paid by us to the said Incumbent for the benefit of the poor of the said parish; And provided also, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same benefice shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the rents, profits, and proceeds of the said tithe commutation rent charges, with their appurtenances, as from the first day of October, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant to the Incumbent for the time being of the vicarage of Alford with the perpetual curacy of Rigsby and Ailby annexed, in the county of Lincoln, and in the diocese of Lincoln, one yearly sum or stipend of one hundred and twenty pounds, such yearly sum or stipend to be payable out of the common fund under our control, and to be calculated as from the tenth day of May, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, and to be receivable half-yearly on the first day of May and on the first day of November in each and every year: Provided always, that the annual sum or stipend so granted by us to the Incumbent of the said vicarage of Alford with the perpetual curacy of Rigsby and Ailby annexed, shall be paid only

upon the production to us on or after the first day of May and the first day of November in each and every year of a certificate under the hand of the Bishop of the said diocese of Lincoln, that an Assistant Curate, duly licensed by such Bishop, has been employed within the parishes aforesaid, during the half-year then ended, and is in receipt of a salary after a rate of not less than one hundred and twenty pounds per annum: Provided also, that such yearly sum or stipend shall continue payable as aforesaid so long only as may to us appear to be expedient under the circumstances from time to time affecting the said benefice of Alford with Rigsby and Ailby.
