We trust that His Royal Highness may be speedily restored to perfect health, and that the same Divine Power which interposed to defeat the purpose of an assassin may continue to protect a life naturally most precious to your Majesty, and endeared also to the country by the fair promise it has already given of future usefulness and distinction.
