a Despatch from Her Majesty's Consul at Alexandria, reporting that the Egyptian General Board of Health has resolved, with the concurrence and approval of the Consular authorities represented there, to issue bills of health gratis to all vessels on departure whatever may be their nationality or destination.

All Egyptian Bills of Health delivered to British vessels will be countersigned by the British Consular Offices at the ports of departure.
