In the Matter of the Railway Companies Powers Act, 1864, and of the application of the Sirhowy Railway Company for a Certificate for authority to raise further capital under the powers of that Act.

NOTICE is hereby given, that in pursuance of the 'Railway Companies' Powers Act, 1864, the Sirhowy Railway Company intend, by memorial under their common seal, to apply to the Board of Trade to issue their certificate that the said Company may be authorised to raise additional capital for the purposes of the certificate, partly by the issue of new shares or new stock, either ordinary or preference, or partly ordinary and partly preference, or partly in that mode or partly by borrowing on mortgage, at

the option of such Company, or as may be prescribed in the certificate, and with power to create and issue debenture stock. Copies of the proposed draft certificate will be supplied as required by the said Act, on application at the Offices of John Newall, Parliamentary Agent, 44, Parliament-street, Westminster.
