d'Affaires, that on and after this date the discriminating duties heretofore levied in French ports upon merchandize imported from the country of its origin in vessels of the United States of America are to be discontinued and abolished: Now, therefore, I, U. S. Grant, President of the United States of America, by virtue of the authority vested in me by an Act of Congress of the 7th day of January, 1824, and by an Act in addition thereto, of the 24th day of May, 1828, do hereby declare and proclaim, that on and after this date, so long as merchandise imported from the countries of its origin into French ports in vessels belonging to citizens of the United States is admitted into French ports on the terms aforesaid, the discriminating duties heretofore levied on merchandize imported from the countries of its origin into the ports of the United States in French vessels shall be and are hereby discontinued and abolished.

In testimony whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the United States to be affixed. Done at the City of Washington, this 12th day of June, in the year of our Lord 1869, and of the independence of the United States of America the ninety-third.
