

be so granted and conveyed by us as aforesaid, shall be and be held to be in lieu of, and in full substitution for, and discharge of, the annual sum or stipend of one hundred and five pounds, heretofore payable by us to the said Incumbent, in respect of the estates which formerly belonged to the deanery of Wells, and also in lieu of, and in full substitution for, and discharge of, the annual sum or stipend of one hundred and twenty-six pounds, heretofore payable by us to the same incumbent, under the provisions of an Order of Her Majesty in Council, bearing date the third day of February, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four: And provided also, that the incumbent, for the time being, of the same vicarage shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the rents, profits, and proceeds of the said pieces or parcels of land, buildings, tithe commutation rent charge, and hereditaments, with their appurtenances, as from the first day of July, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant to the respective Incumbents for the time being of the benefices situate within the original limits of the parish of Manchester, in the county of Lancaster, and in the diocese of Manchester, which are named

in the Schedule hereunto annexed, the respective sums, the amounts of which are set opposite to the names of the said benefices respectively in the second column of such Schedule, the said sums to be payable out of the Common Fund under our control, for and in respect of the year ending the first day of May, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy, in equal moieties, one such moiety to be receivable on the first day of November now next ensuing, and the other on the first day of May following: Provided always, that in the cases of Saint Luke, Chorlton-on-Medlock, and Miles Platting, the payments shall be made by us to such benefices respectively only upon condition that sums of like amount respectively, shall be or shall have been previously received by the respective Incumbents of the said benefices from private sources.
