

JAMES BACON, Esq., one of Her Majesty's Commissioners, authorized to act under a Commission of Bankruptcy, issued the 13th day of October, 1830, against Eleazar Lawrance, late of Ipswich, in the county of Suffolk, Scrivener and Ship Owner, Dealer and Chapman, will sit on the 29th day of November, 1869, at eleven of the clock in the forenoon precisely, at the Court of Bankruptcy, in Basinghall-street, London, in order to make a Dividend of the estate and effects of the said bankrupt; when and where the creditors who have not already proved their debts are to come prepared to prove the same, or they will be excluded the benefit of the said Dividend. And all claims not then proved will be disallowed.

THE estates of Thomas Evans, Hotel Keeper, in Lerwick, were sequestrated on the 29th day of September, 1869, by the Sheriff of the county of Orkney and Zetland.

The first deliverance is dated 14th September, 1869.

The meeting to elect the Trustee and Commissioners, originally appointed and advertized for Tuesday, the 13th October, 1869, has now been appointed by the Court of Session to be held at twelve o'clock, noon, on Tuesday, the 2nd day of November, 1869, within the Sheriff-Court-room, in Lerwick.

A composition may be offered at this meeting; and to entitle creditors to the first dividend, their oaths and grounds of debt must be lodged on or before the 29th day of February, 1870.
