SEWAGE UTILIZATION ACTS 1865 AND 1867.

ORDER SETTLING BOUNDARIES OF THE SPECIAL DRAINAGE DISTRICT OF IVYBRIDGE, IN THE COUNTY OF DEVON.

WHEREAS it is enacted by the Sewage Utilization Act, 1867 (30 and 31 Vict., cap. 113), that any inhabited place not having a known or defined boundary, may petition one of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, in manner provided in the sixteenth section of the Local Government Act, 1858, to settle its boundaries for the purposes of the Sewage Utilization Acts, 1865 and 1867, and the Secretary of State may, by Order made in manner provided by the said section settle the same accordingly, and from and after the date of such Order the place shall be
