WHEREAS due proof has been made to the satisfaction of me the undersigned, Henry Austin Bruce, one of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, that the customs of the Trades carried on in the factories specified in the Schedule hereto, require that the male young persons of at least sixteen years of age working in such factories should be employed in the manner hereinafter mentioned: Now I, the said Henry Austin Bruce, in pursuance of the powers vested in me by the 17th Article of the Schedule annexed to the Factory Acts Extension Acts, 1867, do, by this my Order give permission to the occupiers of the said Factories to employ the male young persons of at least sixteen years of age, not exceeding twenty in number, working in such Factories between the hours of six o'clock in the evening and six o'clock in the following morning, subject to the conditions contained in the said Act.

Northumberland Central Railway Company.

Certificate of the Board of Trade for Authority to Raise Additional Capital.

WHEREAS the Northumberland Central Railway Company have complied with the requirements of "The Railway Companies Powers Act, 1864:"

Now, therefore, the Board of Trade do, by this their Certificate, in pursuance of the said Act, and by virtue and in exercise of the powers thereby in them vested, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, certify as follows:—

Power to issue Preference Shares.

1. The Northumberland Central Railway Company (hereinafter called the Company) are hereby authorized to raise, in addition to the capital already authorized to be raised by them, any further sums not exceeding in the whole the sum of £7,500, by the issue of 750 preference shares of £10 each, bearing interest at the rate of seven per cent. per annum, on the amount of the calls, from time to time, paid in respect thereof.

Rights of Preference Shareholders.

2. Save as herein or under the authority of the Acts incorporated herewith otherwise provided the holders of shares or stock in the additional capital hereby authorized to be raised, shall be entitled to the like rights and privileges, and be subject to the like liabilities, as the holders of shares or stock in the existing ordinary capital of the Company.

Power to raise additional sum by Mortgage.

3. The Company may raise, by borrowing on mortgage, for the purposes of their undertaking, any sum or sums, in addition to the money they are already authorized to borrow, not exceeding in the whole £2,500.

Preference Shares to have Priority over Ordinary Shares.

4. The interest on the preference shares hereby authorized to be issued, shall be paid in priority and preference over the interest or dividend on the ordinary share capital of the Company.

Power to Mortgagees to appoint Receiver.

5. The mortgagees under this Certificate may enforce payment of arrears of principal and interest
