

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the vicarage of Tharston, in the county of Norfolk, and in the diocese of Norwich, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, all those tithe commutation rent charges which are particularly described in the first part of the schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us; and, also, all that piece or parcel of land and hereditaments, with the appurtenances thereunto belonging, particularly described in the second part of such schedule, and likewise now vested in us, to have and to hold the said tithe commutation rent charges and piece or parcel of land and hereditaments with the appurtenances, to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever: Provided always that the said tithe commutation rent charges shall be and be held to be in lieu of, and in substitution for, an annual stipend of three pounds six shillings and eight pence, heretofore payable by us, the said Commissioners, to the Incumbent of the said vicarage, in respect of the same and other tithe commutation rent charges arising within the parish of Tharston aforesaid, formerly belonging to the Bishoprick of Ely: And provided also, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same vicarage shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the rents, profits, and proceeds of the said tithe commutation rent charges and piece or parcel of land and hereditaments, as from the twenty-ninth day of September, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy.
