WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the rectory of Llysaen, in the county of Caernarvon, and in the diocese of Saint Asaph, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same rectory, all those tithe commutation rent-charges which are particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us, to have and to hold the said tithe commutation rent-charges to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever: Provided always, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same rectory shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the rents, profits, and proceeds of the said tithe commutation rent-charges for and in respect of the period intervening between the nineteenth day of March, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two, and the date of the publication of these presents in the London Gazette.
