**O**RDERS for the Court's going into Mourning on Sunday next, the 16th instant, for Her late Majesty The Dowager Empress Caroline Augusta of Austria, Step-Grandmother of His Majesty The Emperor of Austria; viz. :—

The Ladies to wear black Dresses, white Gloves, black or white Shoes, Feathers, and Fans, Pearls, Diamonds, or plain gold or silver Ornaments.

The Gentlemen to wear black Court Dress, with black Swords and Buckles.

The Court to change the Mourning on Sunday, the 2nd of March next; viz. :—

The Ladies to wear black Dresses, with coloured Ribbons, Flowers, Feathers, and Ornaments, or grey or white Dresses, with black Ribbons, Flowers, Feathers, and Ornaments.

The Gentlemen to continue the same Mourning.

And on Sunday, the 9th of March next, the Court to go out of Mourning.
