TREASURY WARRANT.

WE, the Commissioners of Her Majesty's the first day of Ap Treasury, in exercise of all powers given to us by and seventy-three.

the Post Office Acts, or any of them, and of all other powers enabling us in this behalf, do, by this Warrant, under the hands of two of us the said Commissioners, order and direct as follows:—

- 1. The letters described or referred to in the schedule hereto, may be transmitted by the post from the countries and places mentioned or described in the first column, to the countries and places mentioned or described in the second column of the said schedule, without passing through the United Kingdom, at the rates of postage, for the sea conveyance thereof by British packet-boat, or partly by British and partly by Colonial packet-boat, specified in the third column of the said schedule.
- 2. This Warrant shall not prejudice or affect any exemptions or privileges granted by the Post Office Acts, nor the privilege enjoyed by seamen, soldiers, and others employed in Her Majesty's Service, of sending and receiving letters at a reduced rate of postage.
- 3. The rates of postage fixed by this Warrant upon the letters transmitted by the post as herein mentioned, shall be in lieu of those now chargeable for such sea conveyance thereof as aforesaid; and so much of the Warrant of the Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, dated the first day of June, one thousand eight hundred and sixty five, as relates to letters transmitted by the post between any port in Australia, and any port in British India, is hereby repealed.
- 4. This Warrant shall come into operation on the first day of April, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three.
