place.

Cadiz, Nov. 8. This day the New Spain Fleet confisting of 19 Sail, appeared in fight of this Port; feveral Persons are already come ashore from the Ships; from whom we understand, that the Marquis de Laguna, lare Vicercy of Mexico, is come home with them; And that the Vice Admiral Papathino joyned the Fleet this Morning with 5 Men of War. Don Matheo Olaya is now with 7 Men of War at Oran. The Chevalier de Chafteau Renaud continues in this Bay With 4 Ships.

Manbeim, Nov. 14. Yesterday the Garison marched out of this Cittadel, composed of 400 Foor, and a Troop of Horie, and another of Dragoons. And presently after, the Dauphin entred into the Place, and vifited the Fortifications. There were found in the Cittadel 26 Pieces of Brass Cannon, and 63 other Pieces, and two Mortars. The Matelfilal Duke de Duras parted from hence this Morn-

ing to beliege Frankendal.

From the Camp before Frankendal, Nov. 20. The 14th instant the Mareschal de Duras arrived here; He sent the Chevalier de Conreclles to Summon the Governor; who answered, That he would defend the place An OR DINANCE of the KING, as long as he could. The Burgers in containing a Declaration of War against the mean time shewed a great inclination to the Hallanders, which revokes all Passports Capitulare, but were hindred by the Governor The 15th the Dauphin arrived in the many Commerce with them, and enjoyes

Capp accompanied with the Duke de Boad-bon, the Prince de Conti and the Diffe de Manne, and having viewed the Ground, gave Orders for the opening of the Trenches which was done the 16th at Night. Pars, Novemb. 27. The Dauphin parted from Frankendall the 22th instant, and arrived the 25th at Metz in his return hither. It's said, that the Fortifications of Keyferlanter and Manheyn will be demolished and that the Contributions demanded of the Palatinate, amount to Ten Millions five hundred thousand Livres. The States of Languedoc affembled at Nismes, have granted the King two Millions of Livres as a free Gift, and 150 Thouland Livres for the Works of the Canal of Communication between the two Seas.

Paris, Decemb. 1. The Dauphin returned on Sunday last to Verfailles, the King going as far as Sr. Cloud, to meet him. The Court d'Avaux, Ambassador from this Crown in Holland, has Orders to return home. The King's Minister at Vianna, is likewise coming from thence. The Sieur Spanbeim, who has relided here some time in the quality of Envoy Extraordinary from the Elector of Brandenburg has defired Audience of Leave. The Marquis Saignelay parced from hence this Morning to vilit the Sea-Ports, and Arlenals. And the Sieur de Gabarer has Directions to repair to Brest, to Command the 10 Men of
