GENERAL ORDER: Sanitary.

Prescribing Forms under "Artizans and Labourers Dwellings Improvement Act, 1875."

To the Urban Sanitary Authorities entitled to act as Local Authorities under "The Artizans and Labourers Dwellings Improvement Act, 1875":—

And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by Section 6 of "The Artizans and Labourers Dwellings Improvement Act, 1875," the Local Government Board are constituted the "Confirming Authority" for every Improvement Scheme made by an Urban Sanitary Authority in pursuance of that Act;

And whereas by Section 26 of the same Act it is enacted, that the Confirming Authority may from time to time, by Order, prescribe the forms of advertisements and notices under that Act; and that it shall not be obligatory on any persons to adopt such forms, but the same, when adopted, shall be deemed sufficient for all the purposes of that Act:

Now therefore, We, the Local Government Board, as such Confirming Authority as aforesaid, and in pursuance of the powers given by the statutes in that behalf, have caused forms of the advertisements and certain other notices required by the above-recited Act to be framed, and do, by this our Order, prescribe that the advertisements and notices which may be adopted by any Urban Sanitary Authority entitled to act as a Local Authority under the above-recited Act, for the purposes of that Act, shall be as follows; that is to say:—
