GENERAL ORDER of the Local Government Board: Officers' Securities: Altering provisions of Accounts Orders as regards Auditors' Report:—

To the Auditors of the Metropolitan, the West Kent and the West Norfolk Audit District;—

To the Guardians of the Poor of the Westminster and Woolwich Unions;—

To the Directors and Acting Guardians of the Poor within the Hundred of Forehoe (commonly called the Forehoe Incorporation);—

And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by certain Orders of the Poor Law Board bearing date respectively the 22nd day of February, 1869, the 8th day of July, 1868, and the 20th day of May, 1867, addressed to the Guardians of the Poor of the Westminster and Woolwich Unions, and the Directors and Acting Guardians of the Poor within the Hundred of Forehoe (commonly called the Forehoe Incorporation), the Poor Law Board made certain regulations as to the keeping and auditing of the Accounts of the said Guardians, or Directors and

Acting Guardians, and their Officers, and the examination by the Auditor of the securities of such Officers;

And whereas it is required by the said Orders that the Auditor shall, at the close of every audit of the Accounts of the Union or Incorporation next after the 25th day of March in every year, transmit to the Poor Law Board a certain statement in reference to the securities of Officers;

And whereas it is expedient that the requirement above cited should be rescinded, and other provisions made as hereinafter set forth;

Now therefore, we, the Local Government Board, in pursuance of the powers given by the Statutes in that behalf, hereby order as follows:—

ARTICLE I.—So much of each of the above-recited Orders as requires the Auditor to transmit to the Poor Law Board the statement above referred to is hereby rescinded.

ARTICLE II.—As regards each of the said Unions and the said Incorporation, the Auditor shall, at the close of every audit of the Accounts next after the 25th day of March in every year, transmit to the Guardians or the Directors and
