WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinaster mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the vicarage of Clydach, in the county of Glamorgan, and in the diocese of Saint David's, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, all and singular the yearly tithe commutation rent-charges, which are particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us : To have and and to hold the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever : Provided always, that the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges expressed to be hereby granted and conveyed, shall be, and be taken to be, in lieu of and in full substitution for the yearly sum or stipend of one hundred and fifty pounds, heretofore payable by us, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, to the Incumbent for the time being of the said vicarage of Clydach, under the authority of an Order of Her Majesty in Council, bearing date the ninth day of March, in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-seven, and published in the London Gazette on the second day of April, in the same year, to which substitution the Reverend Evan Davies, the present Vicar or Incumbent of the said vicarage is consenting, and in token thereof has signed this instrument : And provided also, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same vicarage shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the profits and proceeds of the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges, for and in respect of the period intervening between the first day of May, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five, and the date of the publication of these presents in the London Gazette.
