

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in consideration of a benefaction represented by a portion amounting to two-thirds or thereabouts of the value of the yearly tithe commutation rent-charges hereinafter referred to, which has been contributed by Sir William Heathcote, of Hursley Park, in the county of Southampton, Baronet, with a view to the augmentation of the vicarage of Hursley, in the same county, and in the diocese of Winchester, do hereby, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the said vicarage of Hursley, and to his successors, Incumbents thereof, all and singular the yearly tithe commutation rent-charges which are particularly set out and described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us: To have and to hold the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever: Provided always, that the Incumbent for the time being of the said vicarage shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the profits and proceeds of the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges for and in respect of the period intervening between the first day of April, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six, and the date of the publication of these presents in the London Gazette.

In witness whereof, we have hereunto set our common seal, this seventeenth day of May in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven.
