

**The Bankruptcy Act, 1869.**

In the County Court of Gloucestershire, holden at Gloucester. In the Matter of William Henry Baldwin, of the parish of Westbury-on-Severn, in the county of Gloucester, Miller, Baker, and Corn Dealer, adjudicated a Bankrupt 22nd June, 1876.
