THE Board of Trade have received from the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs a copy of a Telegram from Her Majesty's Consul-General at Bagdad, announcing that the export of grain and provisions from Turkish Arabia has been prohibited by the Ottoman Government. Despatches have also been received from Her Majesty's Ambassador at Constantinople, announcing the prohibition of the export of cereals from Balthik, and of sheepskins and hides from the Sandjak of Varna.
