

rigg, Ambleside otherwise Ambleside-above-Stock, Windermere, Ambleside otherwise Ambleside-below-Stock, Troutbeck, Applethwaite, Kendal otherwise Kirkby Kendal, Hugill, Over Staveley otherwise Staveley, Strickland Roger, Skelsmergh, Scalthwaite-rigg, Hay and Hutton-i'-th'-Hay, Kendal and Park and Castle Lands, New Hutton (detached), Old Hutton-with-Holmescales, Heversham, Stainton, Preston Richard, Burton (detached), Preston Patrick, Kirkby Lonsdale, Lupton, and Hutton-Roof, all in the county of Westmoreland; Burton, Dalton, Warton, Priest Hutton, Borwick, Melling, Arkholme-with-Cawood, Bolton-le-Sands, Over Kellet, Nether Kellet, Lancaster (detached), Halton otherwise Halton-with-Aughton, Lancaster, Caton, Quernmore, Over Wyersdale, Cockerham, Ellel, Garstang, Nether Wyersdale, Barnacre-with-Bonds, Claughton, Kirkham (detached), Goosnargh-with-Newsham, Whittingham, Ribchester, Alston-with-Hothersall, Preston, Grimsargh-with-Brockholes, Elston, Blackburn, Samlesbury, Leyland, Hoghton, Withnell, Wheelton, Heapey, Whittle-le-Woods, Brindle, Chorley, Standish, Heath Charnock, Adlington, Anderton, Dean, Horwich, Bolton-le-Moors (detached), Lostock, Rumworth, West Houghton, Over Hulton, Middle Hulton, Little Hulton, Eccles, Worsley, Pendlebury, Prestwich-cum-Oldham, and Prestwich, all in the county palatine of Lancaster.

10. A reservoir, adjoining to and on the west side of the existing Prestwich reservoir of the Corporation, to be formed by an embankment to commence at the south-westerly angle of the embankment of the said existing reservoir, thence extending 117 yards or thereabouts in a westerly direction, thence 215 yards or thereabouts in a northerly direction, thence 75 yards or thereabouts in an easterly direction, thence 55 yards or thereabouts in a south-easterly direction, to and terminating at the north-west angle of the embankment of the said existing reservoir; which intended reservoir will be wholly situate in the township of Prestwich, in the parish of Prestwich-cum-Oldham, in the county palatine of Lancaster.
11. An aqueduct, conduit or line of pipes, to commence in and out of the intended reservoir hereinbefore described, at or near the north-easterly corner thereof, and to terminate in the most southerly straining well at the said existing Prestwich reservoir, which said aqueduct, conduit or line of pipes, will be wholly situate in the township of Prestwich, in the parish of Prestwich-cum-Oldham, in the county palatine of Lancaster.
12. An aqueduct, conduit or line of pipes, to commence in and out of the intended aqueduct, conduit or line of pipes ninthly hereinbefore described, in the township of Little Hulton, in the parish of Dean, at a point 525 yards or thereabouts measured in a westerly direction from the centre of the public road called Worsley Trust, along the private road which leads past Old Pay Office to Stone Pit Colliery, such point being in a line with and in continuation of the said private road, and to terminate in the south-westerly corner of the Reservoir No. 5, described in and authorised by the "Manchester Corporation Waterworks and

Improvement Act, 1875," in the township of Denton, in the parish of Manchester; which said aqueduct, conduit, or line of pipes, will pass from, through or into the townships, parishes, and places following, or some of them, that is to say:—Dean, Little Hulton, Eccles, Worsley, Barton-upon-Irwell, Manchester, Stretford, Chorlton-cum-Hardy, Withington, Rusholme, Levenshulme, Gorton, Reddish, and Denton, all in the county palatine of Lancaster:

Together with all proper embankments, bridges, roads, ways, wells, tanks, basins, gauges, filters, dams, sluices, waste weirs, outfalls, discharge pipes, adits, shafts, tunnels, aqueducts, culverts, cuts, channels, conduits, drains, mains, pipes, junctions, valves, telegraphs, engines, works, apparatus, and conveniences connected with the said works, or any of them, or necessary for conducting, inspecting, maintaining, repairing, cleansing, or managing the same.

To declare that the intended works shall, for all purposes whatsoever, inclusive of rents, rates and charges, be deemed part of the waterworks undertaking of the Corporation.

To empower the Corporation to deviate from the lines and levels of the intended works, as shown on the plans and sections thereof to be deposited as hereinafter mentioned.

To empower the Corporation, upon the completion of the diversion of road, and of the intended roads hereinbefore described, to stop up and extinguish all rights of way over and appropriate the sites of the portion of the said existing turnpike-road from Grasmere to Keswick, lying between the commencement and termination of the intended diversion thereof, and also the whole or part of the existing public road on the westerly side of the lake between the commencement of the intended new road as hereinbefore described and the junction of such existing road with the said turnpike-road from Grasmere to Keswick, at the southern end of the lake, and of all other roads, highways, paths and passages in the said township of St. John's Castlerigg and Wythburn, which it may be necessary to stop up for executing the purposes of the intended Act, and to make provision with reference to the repair and maintenance of the intended diversion of the said turnpike-road.

To empower the Corporation to purchase or acquire by compulsion or agreement, or to take on lease any lands, houses or buildings, in or near the several parishes, townships, and places aforesaid, and any rights or easements in, over, or connected with any lands, houses, or buildings which they may require for the purposes of the proposed works or other purposes of the intended Act, and including the drainage area to be made available for the purposes of the intended Act, a portion of which area, consisting of the whole or portions of Castlerigg Fell, Bleaberry Fell, Armboth Fell, Wythburn Fells, Ullscarf, Green Comb, Black Crag, Ash Crag, Steel Fell, Dunmail Raise, Seat Sandal, Birkside, Whelpside, White Side, Helvellyn Screes, and High Fells, in the said township of St. John's Castlerigg and Wythburn, and parish of Crosthwaite, is subject to certain rights of pasturage and other rights, such portion being estimated to contain 8,550 acres or thereabouts; and also including a portion of Grasmere Common, and Dunmail Raise, in the township of Grasmere, and parish of Grasmere, estimated to contain 6 acres or thereabouts, and portions of Hutton-Roof Crag, in the township of Hutton-Roof and parish of Kirkby Lonsdale, estimated to contain
