Council after taking into consideration any such Petition and also any Petition which may be presented to Her by any Coroner of the same county concerning such proposed division or whenever it shall seem fit to Her Majesty to direct the issue of a Writ de Coronatore Eligendo for the purpose of authorizing the election of an additional Coroner above the number of those who have been theretofore customarily elected in such county to order that such county shall be divided into such and so many Districts for the purposes of that Act as to Her Majesty with the advice aforesaid shall seem expedient and to give a name. to each of such districts and to determine at what place within each District the Court for the election of Coroner for such district should be holden as thereinafter provided and every such Order shall be published in the London Gazette.

And whereas by a Petition of the Justices of the Peace for the county of Surrey in General Quarter Sessions assembled at St. Mary Newington in the said county on the ninth day of April one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight, it has

been represented to Her Majesty:

That the county of Surrey (exclusive of the boroughs of Southwark and Guildford and the Duchy of Lancaster) was customarily divided into two districts for the purpose of holding inquests during the space of seven years and upwards before the passing of the said Act and still con-'tinues so, as between the two present Coroners who were each elected for the whole county without reference to such Districts:

That such Districts were customarily called the Eastern and Western Divisions but that the number of inquests in the former Division, in consequence of its large population, greatly exceeds

those held in the latter:

That for the reasons therein set forth it seemed expedient to the Justices that the said county should be divided for the purposes of the said Act into two districts, to be called the Eastern and Western Districts as hereinafter mentioned:

And whereas it has been represented to Her Majesty that the hereinbefore recited provisions of the said Act in reference to the said Petition

have been duly complied with:

And whereas the said Petition with a description of the several proposed Districts and of the boundaries thereof has been duly certified to Her Majesty under the hands and seals of twelve of the said Justices present when such Petition was agreed to; and by the said Petition the said Justices did humbly pray that Her Majesty would be graciously pleased with the advice of Her Privy Council, that from and after the first day of August, one thousand eight hundred and seventyeight, the said county of Surrey should be divided into two Coroners' Districts:

And whereas no Petition has been presented to Her Majesty by either Coroner of the said county

concerning the said proposed division:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty in Council having taken the said Petition into consideration, is pleased by and with the advice of Her Privy Council to grant the prayer thereof, and to declare, order, and determine:

That the said county of Surrey, shall be divided into two Coroners' Districts, to be called the Eastern and Western District, and to comprise the following parishes, townships, and places, videlicet :-
