on the south-west by the Nottingham Canal, on the south-east by an imaginary line commencing at a point in the south-western boundary of the Midland Railway 830 feet measured south-east from the bridge, which carries the Ilkeston-road over the said railway, and running in a south-westerly direction, and terminating in the north-eastern boundary of the Nottingham Canal at a point 183 feet measured along the north-eastern boundary of that canal from the junction therewith of the fence forming the northwest boundary of the field or close, part of a field known as Beck Field, and in the occupation of William Allcock, and bounded on the north-west by another imaginary line commencing at a point in the south-western boundary of the said railway 350 feet from the point therein hereinbefore described measured along such boundary, drawn parallel to the imaginary line above described, and terminating in the said north-eastern boundary of the Nottingham Canal, and containing an area of five acres or thereabouts.

6. To empower the Corporation to purchase or acquire by agreement the last-mentioned piece of land, and all property, rights, and interests therein.

7. To empower the Corporation, within the district in which they are authorized to supply gas, to make, provide, and supply light for public and private purposes, not only by means of gas, but by electricity, or by any other means, materials, or processes which are already discovered or invented, or which may hereafter be discovered or invented, and for such purposes to use and make applicable all or any of the mains, pipes, machinery, works, and property being at any time the gas undertaking of the Corporation, and other the lands and property of the Corporation, and the streets, roads, ways, and public places under their control or management.

8. To authorize the Corporation to purchase and acquire, either wholly or partially, any patent or patents, or other rights and privileges, or any licence or licences to use any patent or patents applicable or deemed applicable to the manufacture and supply of gas or residual products, or to the making or supply of light by electricity, or by any other means, materials, or processes whatsoever:

9. To authorize the Corporation in their municipal capacity, or as the Urban Sanitary Authority for the district or borough of Nottingham, to purchase and to transfer and vest, or provide for the transfer and vesting, to and in the Corporation, of the undertaking works, lands, waters, property (real and personal), powers, rights, privileges, and authorities now belonging, or which at any time may belong to the Nottingham Waterworks Company (hereinafter called the Water Company), for such price or consideration, and upon such terms, conditions, and stipulations as may be agred upon between the Corporation and the Water Company, or as may be settled by arbitration, or as may be expressed and contained in or provided for by the intended Act.

10. To empower the Corporation to carry on the undertaking of the Water Company, and for that purpose to have all usual and necessary powers for breaking up streets, roads, and places, for laying, maintaining, repairing, and renewing mains, pipes, and other works, and for the purchase, sale, letting, hiring, or otherwise dealing in meters, fittings, and other apparatus, articles, and things, and for the sale, supply, and consumption of water, and to have and exercise all or any of

the powers, rights, authorities, and privileges of the Water Company in as full and ample a manner in all respects as that Company can or may lawfully exercise the same, and also such further and other powers, rights, authorities, and privileges with respect to the several matters aforesaid as may be thought expedient or proper with respect to the supply of water by the Corporation.

II. To authorize the Corporation and the Water Company to enter into and carry into effect agreements with respect to the several matters aforesaid, or any of them, and to confirm any such agreements between the Corporation and that Company relating to the said matters as may have been entered into prior to the passing of the intended Act, and to provide for the winding up of the affairs of the Water Company, and the distribution of their assets, and to dissolve the said Company.

12. To empower the Corporation to supply water by meter, and to sell or let on hire meters, fittings, and other apparatus.

13. To enable the Corporation on the one hand, and any Company, local board, sanitary authority, public body, officers, or persons on the other hand, to enter into and carry into effect contracts, agreements, and arrangements for or with respect to the supply by the Corporation to any such Company, local board, sanitary authority, or public body, officers, or persons, of water, in bulk or otherwise, for any public, sanitary, trading, or other purposes, and to authorize any such Company, local board, sanitary authority, public body, officers, or persons respectively to apply their respective funds, and to raise further moneys for the purpose of any such contract, agreement, or arrangement, and to sanction and confirm any such contract, agreement, or arrangement already made, or which, prior to the passing of the intended Act, may be made with respect to the matters aforesaid.

14. To authorize the Corporation to sell, let, or otherwise dispose of any part or parts of the lands and property which may be acquired by them under the intended Act, and to apply the moneys produced thereby in or towards any of the objects of the intended Act, or in aid of the borough fund, district fund, and general district rates, as the Corporation shall think fit.

15. And the intended Act will contain a provision for enabling Her Majesty's Judges of Assize to sit and hold assizes, sittings, and hearings for the Town and County of the Town of Nottingham, in the County Hall or Shire Hall, in the county of Nottingham, situated in the town of Nottingham, and for the making and carrying into effect of agreements and arrangements with respect thereto, and will also contain a provision that all the districts, parishes, and portions of parishes and places, being parts of the present borough of Nottingham, and which were added thereto and comprised therein by virtue of the Nottingham Borough Extension Act, 1877, shall be deemed to be and be comprised in and parts of the Town and County of the Town of Nottingham.

16. A provision will also be contained in the intended Act for enabling the Returning Officer at any Municipal Election held in the borough of Nottingham to exercise such and the like powers to use any room in a school receiving a grant out of moneys provided by Parliament, and any room the expense of maintaining which is payable out of any local rate as are conferred on a Returning Officer at a Parliamentary Election by section 6 of Ballot Act, 1872, and to make that section applicable to Returning Officers at all Municipal Elections held within the grid horough.
