THE Board of Trade have received through the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs a copy of a Telegram from Her Majesty's Ambassador at Constantinople, reporting that the Turkish Board of Health have decided—with a view of preventing the spread of plague from Russia—that vessels arriving from Russian ports are to be subjected to medical observation for 24 hours; that goods for Turkey susceptible of transmitting plague are to be disinfected; that a health-guard is to accompany vessels passing through the Straits without touching; and that the visa of the Ottoman Consil is to be required to bills of health from Black Sea ports, and the visa of the Consul at Kertch to those from the Sea of Azov.
